

Testing Services

The psychologists at Village Family Psychiatry provide a variety of testing services to children (6 years of age +), adolescents, and adults, including the following:

- Neuropsychological testing
- Psychological testing
- Psychoeducational assessments
- Accommodations assessments (e.g., SAT, LSAT)
- Independent educational evaluations (IEE)
- Special education second opinions
- Presurgical screening evaluations

Evaluations are helpful for those who have a history of or are concerned about conditions such as:

- Attention Deficit/Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD)
- Autism Spectrum Disorder
- Dementia
- Developmental delays
- Intellectual disability
- Learning disability
- Memory impairment
- Mood and anxiety disorders (e.g., depression, bipolar disorder)
- Traumatic or acquired brain injury
